



Director's Report to Members Annual General Meeting October 27th 2010

Dear members and supporters,

I would like to express my deep thank you to all of you for supporting Kampuchea House and also to inform about our activities and results that we have achieved from January to the present date. In addition, I would like to report to all of you as below:

I. Administration Report

- Meeting and submitted yearly report to Ministry of Interior in Phnom Penh.
- Meeting with the Commune Chief and Village Chief about the installation of Kampuchea House's signs, cutting the tamarind tree that very close to house 3, and reintegrated Houn Doung and Pheak Sophary, the older girls back to her home.
- Meeting with the Department of Social Affairs, Veteran, Youth and Rehabilitation every two months about the care of the children, welfare, education, health, child violence and smuggling, and child right that cooperated and funded by UNICEF.
- Meeting with the Officer of Social Affairs of Sotnikum District and Angkor Thom District about to process reintegrated document of Doung and Sophary and meeting with their family members explained about the finishing project of the two girls and what the two girls could be a self dependence person.
- Meeting with others NGOs that working with the vulnerable children, and women in Siem Reap Province.
- Participated the conference that held at the Sotnikum District Office.
- Informed to the concerned authority about the bike ride 2010 on the way that we will going pass for security reason.
- Sent resident report to the Commune Police officer.
- Participated School's Day ceremony of the academic year 2010-2011 and meeting with all children guardians and all teachers about student attendance that irregularly and Child dropping school.

II. Children Report:

- Since January until now nearly all children have been celebrated their birthday, but only Reth Sak will celebrated in December when his turn comes.
- Kampuchea House new T-shirts have been given to all the children with its name attached and birthday present with new clothes for all them.



- School uniform and facilities have been provided to every child for the new academic year 2010-2011.

- Doung and Sophary graduated from her Hospitality school and now they are get a job.

- Sophary now is working in Phnom Penh in Sofitel Hotel, while Doung is working in Siem Reap Restaurant and Bar called The Station.

- Peach now finishes her training of Hairdressing with the good result for her to get a job in the future. During the hard time now she still goes to the training shop to practice and we try to get a job for her.

III. Education Report:

-New English Teacher for the community children who most of them from Keansanke Primary School where our children go to study has been started since January till August, providing free English lesson and this lesson has been finished due to the teachers resigned.

-The new English teacher has been continued in October, but for our children only with three days per week and two hours per day from 5:30pm to 7:30pm.

-Even though I did not get in written report from the children's teachers, I have got the verbal admire from the School Principle that our children are so smart and clever. As a result all of them are promoted to new grade in this new studying year.

-Rea, the youngest children now, starts her school in kindergarten.

- Doung and Sophary graduated from her training course of bakery.

- Peah finished her hairdressing study.

- Some children study record that I have gotten from the first quarter of 2010 in the academic year 2009-2010 are shown in the below chart:

IV. Health Report:

- January: took Thai, Chanratt, Rina, Veasnar and Ith to Kuntha Bopha Hospital to check their bad cold and took Yim and Yeth to RHAC clinic for her TB injection. The weather was cool in January.

-February: Took Chantrea to the provincial hospital.

-March: No one has been sick, but Kheng the Vice Director and Orphanage Manager took two poor children to Kuntha Bopha Hospital because one was bitten by snake and one was gotten cholera.

-April: No one has been sick.

-May: Chanry had stomachache.

-June: Thai had cough, Chary had headache, Sameany had headache and nose bleed.

-July: Thai had blood test with Sameanya and the result; they were lack of sugar and worm. The worm medicines have been provided for all children. Minea had cold.

-August: Pisey had teeth ache and I took Chinh and Sokhon to Phnom Penh to have blood check again at Pasteur Institute. The result was they did not have Hep C.

-September: Took Pisey and Veasnar to Dentist Clinic in Siem Reap, Thai has mouth blister, and Rea has an ear ache.

-October: Hun has ear ache, Mean and Sor have a fever.



V. Maintenance and Building Report:

- January: Added 50 trucks of soil at the laundry place, and built the concrete boundary fence.
- February: Added 90 trucks of soil at the laundry place, and bought 200 timber posts to make the fence along the boundary. The concrete boundary had finished.
- March: changed the standing sand layer, fine sand layer and gravel of the water filtration system. Fix the leaking storage tank.
- April: Bought some play ground equipments for the children and solar water pump did not working and get it fix.
- May: built flag poles, and the laundry place.
- June: built the new dishwashing sink, the stand to put the blue plastic water tank close to the Community Center, and renovated all the pipes underground. Grown zucchini, wax gourd, eggplant, water convolvulus and lemon trees at the back yard of the land.
- July: Solar panels system has been checked
- August: Changed water taps in kitchen and fix the pipe.
- September: Fix the motor pump, the concrete around the shower block has been crack and did not fix yet.

VI. Visitor Report:

In 2010 not only the committee members but also some different visitors came to visit the orphanage and spending their time to play with our children and offered some toys, game equipments, school facilitators and donated the money to support. Some of the committee members had spent their time to take the children out to visit the temples, cultural village, water fall and to the good restaurants with the good meal. As a result we have got 23 times that we welcome the visitors that some of them were come alone and some come in group.

VII. Staff Report:

-Mr.Nou Meng Hom, the assistant to the Orphanage Manager, has been married and the celebrated his second wedding party at the orphanage with provided a new experience to our children that we are really a family one in the society. Many honor guests have been invited for his party.

- Unfortunately, our English teachers have been resigned by August due to his main responsibility at the public school. Mr. Keo Chhay Yath, the English teacher for our children and the principle of Keansangke Secondary School and Mr. Sim Sophal, the English Teacher for outside children and the Vice Principle were busy to prepare for new school curriculum and to meet the donor for sponsoring the School.

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- Socheat, Khmer teacher, took her annual leave to train pedagogy at Battambang Province to upgrade her position in public civil servant from Primary School teacher to Secondary school teacher.

- In recently, Mr. Soem Phalla, the new English teacher for our children, has been started his class every three day per week and he is happy to drive his motor bike from Siem Reap town to the Orphanage which is about 40km in the dark on the way back to teach our children.

VIII. Future Plans:

- Build two new houses and select other 12 children and two house mothers.
- Build another boundary fence.
- More water tanks should be installed to store more water.
- Enlarge kitchen room.
- Add more solar panels and butteries for new house to supply enough power.
- The first aid staff or nurse should be employ when more children are resided.
- Home garden and poultry farm should be designed and get it done to cut some expending cost.
- Children holiday is in planning for November 2010.

IX. General:

- Now Kampuchea House is the best partners with the Department of Social Affairs, Veteran, Youth and Rehabilitation in Siem Reap Province and Sotnikum District and with other NGOs. After, its officers came to inspect the orphanage for 2010 report to the Royal Government of Cambodia; they scored our orphanage 76/100 among 30 orphanages in Siem Reap. The ranking will be announced at the end of the year.

Moreover, all the staff are happy with their work and achievement and they try hard to keep the good name and reputation of Kampuchea House. They always regard the children as the same as their family members and dedicate to their job which make all the children safe, secure, and healthy.

We all would like to thank you to all the committee members and benefactors for your generous support and you will continue to support us and wishes you good health and the best wishes. Thank you.
