TOURISM COURSE AT FEEDING DREAMS FOR CHAN REY AND RINA.

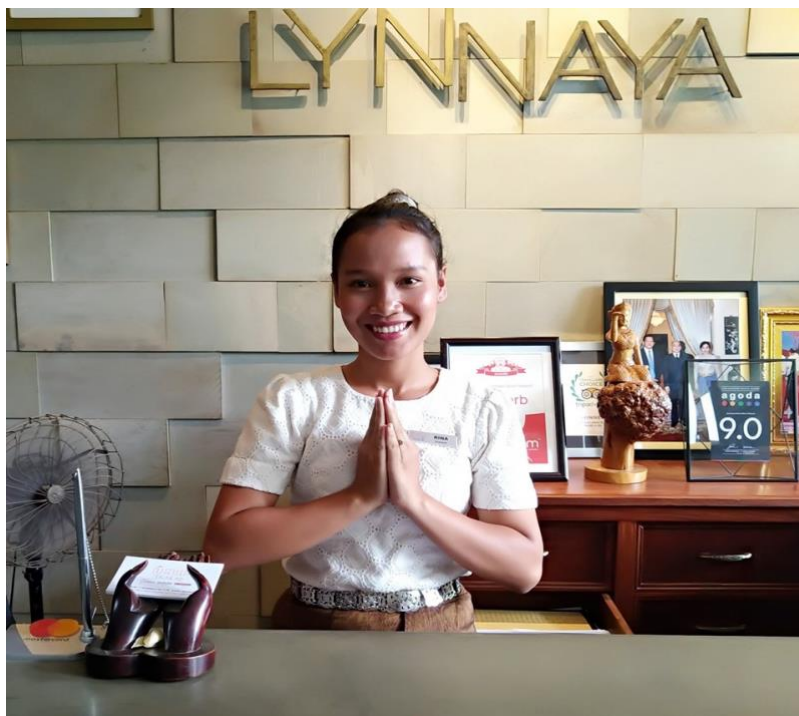
Both Chan Rey and Rina are enjoying working at boutique hotels in Siem Reap during a three month internship, which forms part of their tourism course at Feeding Dreams.


